



Christopher Wolf chairs the International Network Against Cyber-Hate (INACH). His participation in INACH started through his service as a senior lay leader of the Anti-Defamation League where he chairs the ADL Internet Task Force, addressing anti-Semitism and hate on the Internet. In his work against misuse of the Internet, Mr. Wolf has written and spoken widely, including at OSCE meetings in Paris and Warsaw, and in Berlin, Stockholm, London, Herzliya, Jerusalem, and across the United States. He has made numerous presentations in the United States Congress on the subject, and has authored Op Eds in the *International Herald Tribune*. Professionally, Mr. Wolf is a litigation partner with the international law firm of Proskauer Rose LLP, where he is an Internet lawyer. At Proskauer, he chairs the Privacy and Data Security Practice Group and the Diversity Committee. MSNBC has called Mr. Wolf “a pioneer in Internet law”, reflective of involvement in precedent setting cases since the start of the Internet era. He is the editor and lead author of the Practising Law Institute (PLI) treatise entitled *Proskauer on Privacy: A Guide to Privacy and Data Security Law in the Information Age*.
