One morning I was in the car on my way to work. There was plenty of discussion on the radio about someone who shot a police officer in America at close range. On the radio, a teacher from college was contacted. He was asked whether this is seen as a terrorist attack. What this teacher said then left a deep impression on me. He said that it was not the case because the perpetrator did not say Allahu ekber beforehand. The reason why I find this very impressive is that this highly trained teacher thinks that everyone who calls Alahu ekber is portrayed as a terrorist or the act he committed is seen as terrorist, this is a Muslim person. If it were a Western person, it would not be seen as a terrorist but as someone who was or is not psychologically stable.
