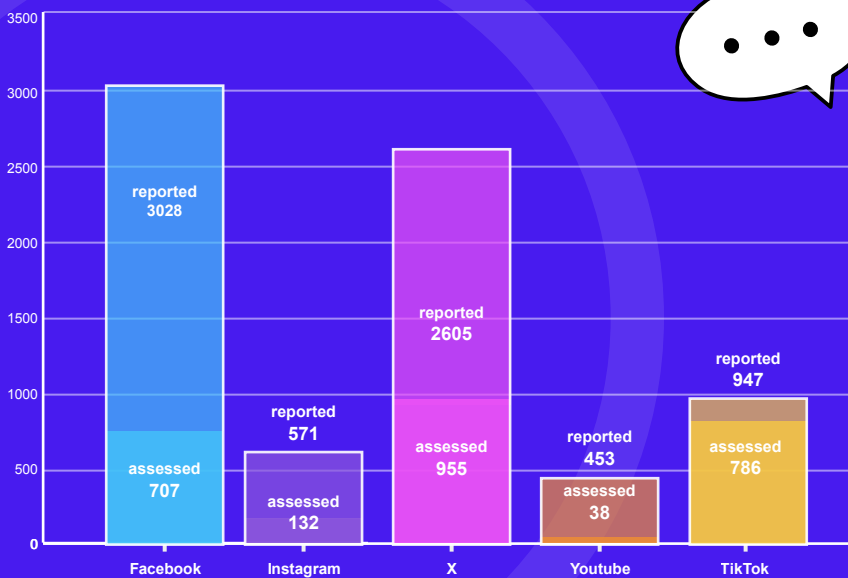


Time of assesment of notifications

Removals per IT company



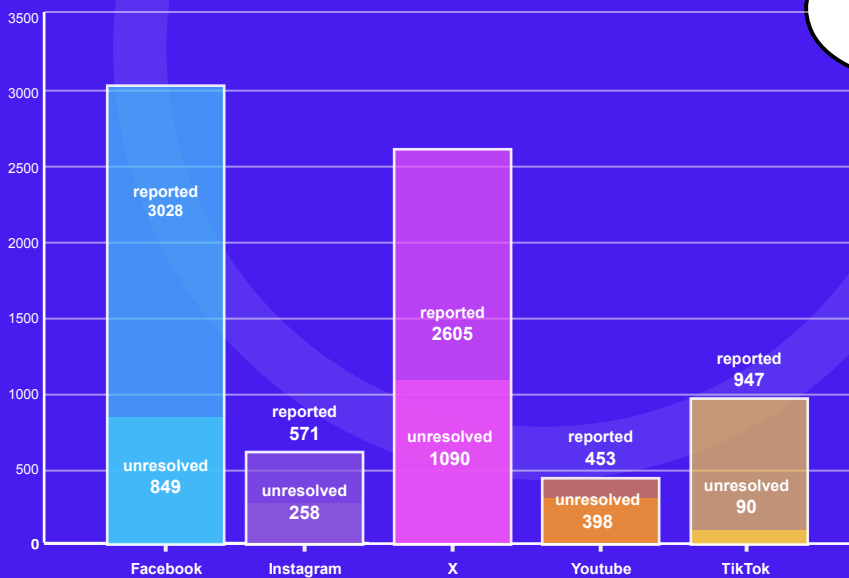
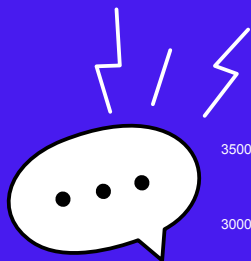

Number of notifications with no feedback



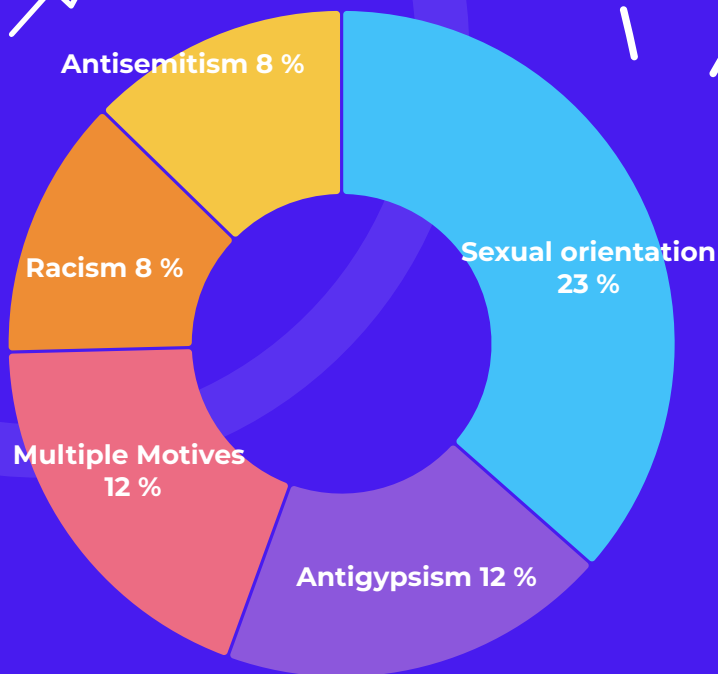

Grounds for reporting hate





Summary

Problems with reporting as a regular user persist in most countries. The SafeNet partners continue to report that trusted flagger status has to be revoked in order for hateful comments to be addressed/removed. Some partners report positive experiences with TikTok. There was a surge in anti-Muslim and antisemitic content, often not addressed/removed by the platforms. Generally, the number of reports not addressed at all and not removed is on the increase. The issue of the limited visibility approach makes no sense; the content is still available/visible, albeit from different locations.
